Construction contractors must be sponsored.

Sponsorships are **project-specific.**

SECURITY CLEARANCES

Security clearances are required to work at ATL.

FBI

Criminal History
Records Check (CHRC)

TSA

Security Threat
Assessment (STA)

Processing time for background checks is not managed by the DOA Security department.

SECURITY BADGING

Security Identification Display Area (SIDA)

- Government - Blue
- Airline - Green
- Contractor - Brown
- Concessionaire – Red

Sterile Area

- Non-SIDA - White

Public Area

- Public – Black

SECURITY VEHICLE ACCESS PERMITS

Vehicle Markings:

- **Body**
- **Door**
- **Window**
- **Logo**
- **Amber beacon light**

SECURITY PLAN



A **project-specific** Security Plan must be submitted to DOA Security for review and approval prior to project commencement.

SECURITY FEES

- **Fingerprinting - \$50**
- **Identification Badge - \$60**
- **Badges Not Returned - \$200**
- **Vehicle Permit - \$50**
((\$10 million insurance policy required for Airport Operations Area driving))
- **Breach Of Rules Notice - \$250, \$500, \$1,000**
